



Guichenotia macrantha 'Dwarf' PBR

Our plant in focus is *Guichenotia macrantha* 'Dwarf'. This small shrub is an improved form of the *Guichenotia macrantha* and has lots of potential for commercial landscapes. Its high adaptability to soil types and sun, coupled with its stunning winter display of flowers makes it a perfect choice to consider for your next project.

COMMON NAME: Yanchep Bell - Dwarf From

BOTANICAL NAME: *Guichenotia macrantha* 'Dwarf'

ORIGIN: A select clonal form of the Yanchep Bell. Plantrite have developed this line over many years.

HABIT: A small shrub with a compact growing habit. Grows 0.8m high and 1m wide.

FEATURES: *Guichenotia macrantha* 'Dwarf' produces unique, delicate bell shaped mauve flowers during winter that contrast with its green-grey foliage, making it a great point of interest in design over winter.

USES: Ideal for borders, medians, verges, parks and reserves. Great at attracting birds and insects. Excellent as a design plant.

POSITION/SOIL: It is suited to a wide range of positions as it thrives in the full sun or light shade and is tolerant of all soils particularly coastal and limestone, preferring well-drained soil.

CULTIVATION: These plants are grown via cutting propagation from select parent stock to ensure a healthy and uniform plants.

MANAGEMENT: *Guichenotia macrantha* 'Dwarf' is drought tolerant once established and requires minimum maintenance and watering. This shrub requires little pruning and extra fertilising is not required once established.
