Registration Closing Date: 5pm Friday 31 May 2019 – no late entries will be accepted after this time.

Entry Costs

Series Events Entry: \$20 (includes entry into the centre).
 State Championships Entry: \$40 per competitor (includes entry into the centre).
 Entries will be done by club administrators/surf sports directors through the SLSA Carnival Manager System. Any member that wishes to participate in these events will need to go through their club processes to enter SLSWA events.

Additional Rules

- Clubs are asked to enter people through the online entry system for the following positions (Time Keepers and Officials) prior to the each Series Event and the State Championships. Or Notify Graham Snook by email: gsnook@slnwa.com.au
- Time Keepers:
To assist with timing each competing club is asked to supply two time keepers per series event and State Championship. The time keepers can be rotated with other Volunteers throughout the day.
- Officials:
Qualified officials are a major requirement of Pool Rescue events. The following competitors to official ratios apply to all clubs competing at SLSWA Pool Rescue Events:
 - 1-5 Competitors = 1 Official
 - 6+ Competitors = 2 Officials
