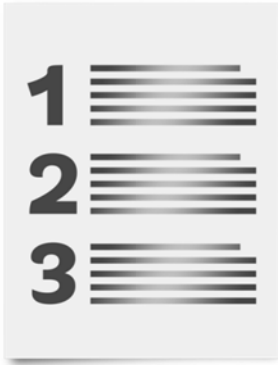

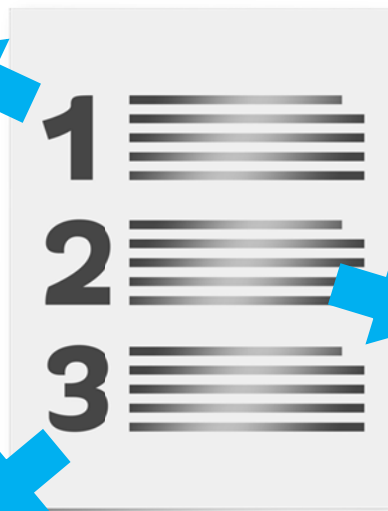

- family and friends



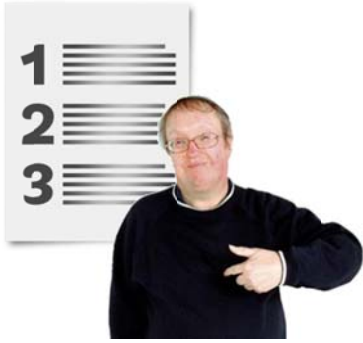
- carers
