Snapshot of survey results - Heritage South Australia, November 2017

You said...

"The park lands are a rare jewel"

"Without the park lands, it is not Adelaide."

"Park lands are vital to our health and pleasure"

"provide a very beautiful welcome point of difference for visitors"

1,747 people did the 9-question survey.

97% agreed that the Adelaide Park Lands were important to them.

88% thought that the Adelaide Park Lands should be State heritage-listed.

42.6% thought the most significant aspect of the Adelaide Park Lands was 'Open space, significant trees, flora and fauna habitats'

Top answers



- 1st • Open space, significant trees, flora and fauna habitats
- 2nd • Liveability of city
- 3rd • Venue for community events
- 4th • Colonel Light's plan and layout
- 5th • Cultural significance to SA community
- 6th • Historical value
- 7th • Sport and recreation
