<p>Class 2 BYO – a short term licence is a BYO class if the licence authorises only the consumption of liquor (and not the sale or supply of liquor)</p>	201 or up to 1,200 at any one time	2am	12 per calendar year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> > Art galleries > Museums > Tourism operator wishing to provide food but allowing patrons to bring their own liquor for consumption 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> > By application 30 days prior to the event (including plan) > Council will be notified of the application (similar to ongoing applications) > Must not have prescribed entertainment > Landlord consent required > Will need to comply with the General Code of Practice
