

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS STORE SALE MARKET REPORT Friday – 7th October 2022

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 4,060 Store cattle consisting of 1,685 Steers, 544 Mickeys, 1,758 Heifers 50 Cows and 23 Cows & Calves.

Cattle were made up of some very good quality lines and small runs of secondary types from the North and North West. Buyers paid premiums for the quality cattle which were in strong demand. The yarding was drawn from Croydon, Upper Daintree, Collinsville, Mt Isa, Normanton, Greenvale, as well as local and coastal areas.
