

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME SALE MARKET REPORT Wednesday – 26th April 2023

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1150 cattle. The Prime cattle consisted of 172 Bullocks, 96 Heifers, 771 Cows and 111 Bulls.

Cattle comprised of a good quality yarding of predominately lines of well finished Cows and smaller consignments of both Bullocks and Bulls. All categories sold to a strong and competitive buying panel with all the usual processors present and active throughout the sale.

The yarding was drawn from Julia Creek, Mt Isa, Richmond, Einasleigh, Mt Garnet as well as local and coastal areas.

<u>Prime Quotes:</u> Bullocks were 8¢ dearer, Heifers were 5¢ dearer, Cows were unchanged and firm, and Bulls were 8¢ dearer on last week's rates.

- The top pen of Cows were sold by DAFF for 274¢/kg, weighing 532kg to return \$1,457 per head.
- A run of 230 Cows sold on A/c Maitland Grazing, "Oak Valley Station", Einasleigh to average 256¢/kg for 461kg returning \$1,180 per head.
- Bulls sold on a/c Bernice Frau topped at 310¢/kg and weighed 595kg, to return \$1,844 per head.
