

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE MARKET REPORT Wednesday – 24th May 2023

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2001 cattle, consisting of 863 prime cattle & 1138 store cattle. The prime cattle consisted of 112 bullocks, 89 heifers, 600 cows and 62 bulls. The store cattle consisted of 565 steers, 193 mickeys, 378 heifers and 20 cows & calves.

Cattle comprised of smaller lines of Bullocks and Heifers which varied in condition and quality. Isolated pens of well finished cows sold to Meatworks at slightly reduced rates which are competitive with all other major selling centers in the state. Most processors were in attendance and operating.

The yarding was drawn from Mt.Isa, Hughenden, Forsayth, Einasleigh, Georgetown, Mt.Garnet, Greenvale as well as local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes:

Bullocks were quoted Unchanged, Heifers were 5¢ dearer, Cows 8-10¢ easier, and Bulls were firm on last week's rates.

Store cattle were made up of smaller consignments of good quality mid to light weight Brahman weaner steers which sold firm compared to last Friday's Store Sale.

Heifers above 250kg sold to firm rates compared to last Fridays Store Sale with those under 250kg experiencing further discounts.
