

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE MARKET REPORT Wednesday – 9th August 2023

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2,019 cattle, consisting of 937 Prime Cattle and 1082 Store Cattle. The Prime Cattle consisted of 347 Bullocks, 84 Heifers, 438 Cows and 68 Bulls. Store Cattle consisted of 318 Steers, 639 Heifers and 4 Cows & Calves.

The yarding comprised of well finished Prime cattle which met increased competition from four meatworks operators and two live exporters. There were a couple of good lines of prime Western Bullocks from Burketown, Mt Isa and McKinlay as well as several smaller lines of well finished meatworks Heifers and Cows from the local area. The overall yarding was drawn from Burketown, Mt Isa, McKinlay, Hughenden, Georgetown, Bowen, Mt Coolon, as well as the local area.

<u>Prime Quotes</u>: Bullocks were quoted 5¢ dearer, Heifers were 10¢ dearer, Cows were 10¢ dearer, and Bulls were 10¢ dearer on last week's rates.

- A pen of heavy weight Santa Cross Bullocks on a/c AM & JL Hollingsworth, sold to 268¢/kg, weighing 743kg to return \$1,992/hd.
- Best Priced trade Heifers were presented on a/c Brown & Sons, "Beenfield", McKinlay sold for 250¢/kg, weighing 456kg to return \$1,141 per head.
- The top pen of Cows were sold on a/c Matthews Cattle P/L for 236¢/kg, weighing 567kg to return \$1,338 per head.
- Bulls sold on a/c MR Stanger & KJ Gilligan made 286¢/kg and weighed 800kg to return \$2,289 per head.

Store Quotes: There was a mixed yarding of Steers and Mickeys, with prices reflecting the quality on offer. A couple of good lines of Heifers 260kg and over sold firm to slightly dearer however those under 260kg did not attract as much interest and anything sub 200kg struggled.
