Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 4,750 Store Cattle.

Cattle consisted of 1,907 Steers, 1,138 Mickeys, 1,674 Heifers, 10 Cows and 21 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of a great lineup of quality weaners with a small selection of heavy feeder cattle on offer. The yarding was drawn from Normanton, Richmond, Camooweal, Hughenden, as well as local and coastal areas.

Store Quotes:

Store cattle were made up of several larger consignments of lightweight weaner cattle, with a higher percentage of Crossbreds offered than usual. Buyers paid premiums for lines of Crossbred cattle whilst Brahmans met solid demand selling firm on last week's rates.
