

# CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS

## PRIME SALE MARKET REPORT

### Wednesday – 16<sup>th</sup> July 2025

**Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2,208 Prime cattle.**  
**The cattle consisted of 205 Bullocks, 535 Heifers, 1,252 Cows and 216 Bulls.**

Cattle comprised of fewer Bullocks, a larger line of prime Heifers and a lighter line of well finished Cows than were presented last week. The yarding was drawn from Mount Isa, Richmond, Hughenden, Burketown, Normanton, Georgetown, Ingham as well as local and coastal areas.

**Prime Quotes:** Bullocks were quoted unchanged, Heifers were 10¢ easier, Cows were 10¢ easier and Bulls were unchanged on last week's rates.

- Bulls sold on A/c G Keilar, "Jardineview" Prairie topped at 316¢/kg and weighed 690kg, to return \$2,181 per head.
