STORE SALE MARKET REPORT

Friday – 18th July 2025

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2,245 Store cattle.
The cattle consisted of 1,239 Steers, 244 Mickeys, 747 Heifers and 15x15 Cows & Calves.

The cattle were made up of only a few good lines of Steers which sold to similar rates. The majority of the yarding was very mixed quality and sold to a cheaper trend.

- A pen of 24 Brahman Feeder Steers A/c Brown & Sons, "Scottsburn". Richmond made 304¢/kg and weighed 428kg, returning an average of \$1,300 per head.
- A line of 51 Brangus Backgrounder Steers A/c Flinders River Cattle Co, "Beckers", Clare sold for 398¢/kg to weigh 312kg and return \$1,243 per head.
- A line of 87 Brahman Backgrounder Steers A/c WH & DE Alford, "Collopy", Mingela sold for 302¢/kg to weigh 289kg and return \$875 per head.
- A good pen of 10 Heifers on A/c WJ & KL Bethel, "Jenkins Creek", Georgetown made 264¢/kg, weighed 336kg returning an average of \$887 per head.
- 15 x 15 Cows & Calves on A/c of various vendors sold between \$650-\$900 per unit.
