STORE SALE MARKET REPORT Friday – 25th July 2025

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 3,067 Store cattle.

The cattle consisted of 1,599 Steers, 1,375 Heifers, 75 Store Cows and 18 Cows & Calves.

Store Cattle were made up of predominately light weight Brahman Steers & Heifers with isolated pens of Feeder weight cattle. All categories still receiving firm competition from both restockers and feed lotters, Buyers again were very active on any suitable crossbred types.

The yarding was drawn from Mt Isa, Richmond, Hughenden, Burketown, Croydon, Einasleigh, Mt Garnet as well as local and coastal areas.
