

PRIME SALE MARKET REPORT Wednesday – 20th August 2025

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 3,275 Prime cattle. The cattle consisted of 989 Bullocks, 244 Heifers, 1870 Cows and 172 Bulls.

Cattle comprised of a larger than normal yarding of prime cattle with all categories selling to a firm or slightly dearer trend based on previous weeks. A full panel of regular and southern processors were in attendance with competition remaining solid.

The yarding was drawn from Georgetown, Mt Isa, Richmond, Hughenden, Torrens Creek, Prairie, Clermont as well as local and coastal areas.

Bullocks were quoted unchanged, Heifers were also unchanged, Cows were 10° dearer, and Bulls were unchanged on last week's rates.
