

PRIME SALE MARKET REPORT Wednesday – 10th September 2025

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 3,093 Prime cattle consisting of 1,009 Bullocks, 441 Heifers, 1,427 Cows and 216 Bulls.

Cattle comprised of some good lines of well finished Bullocks and Cows with all finished types selling strong with lighter conditioned cattle receiving mixed competition. The yarding was drawn from Mt Isa, Burketown, Normanton, Croydon, Cloncurry, Julia Creek, Richmond, Mt Garnet, Tully, Clermont, Einasleigh as well as local and coastal areas.

Bullocks were quoted 5-10¢ dearer, Heifers were unchanged, Cows were 10-15¢ easier, and Bulls were 20-40¢ dearer on last week's rates.
