

# CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS

## STORE SALE MARKET REPORT

### Friday – 19<sup>th</sup> September 2025

**Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2,699 Store cattle consisting of 719 Steers, 1,500 Heifers, 5 Cows and 475 Mickeys.**

Cattle comprised of another mixed quality yarding consisting of mainly feeder weight Steers and Heifers which seen increased competition. Secondary type cattle still receiving subdued rates with limited interest. Isolated pens of better Brahman and Crossbred Weaner Steers made similar rates to last week.

The yarding was drawn from Mt Isa, Hughenden, Greenvale, Georgetown, Einasleigh, as well as local and coastal areas.
