

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS

PRIME SALE MARKET REPORT Wednesday – 1st October 2025

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2,514 Prime cattle consisting of 571 Bullocks, 293 Heifers, 1292 Cows and 358 Bulls.

Cattle comprised of some good lines of quality heavy Bullocks and Cows. Accompanied by a larger yarding of secondary type cattle selling to a firm or slightly dearer trend. Demand for heavy cattle improved with an additional processor active, all other regular processors were in attendance.

The yarding was drawn from Mt Isa, Cloncurry, Richmond, Hughenden, Normanton, Georgetown, Einasleigh as well as local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes: Bullocks were quoted 20¢ dearer, Heifers were 25¢ dearer, Cows were firm, and Bulls were up 10¢ on last week's rates.
