PRIME SALE MARKET REPORT

Wednesday – 8th April 2026

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 937 cattle.
The Prime cattle consisted of 351 Bullocks, 102 Heifers, 435 Cows and 49 Bulls.

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded isolated pens of heavy Bullocks, prime Heifers & well finished Cows, with minimal Bulls throughout the yard. Cattle presented well, with similar market trends that we are seeing throughout the state. The yarding was drawn from Richmond, Einasleigh, Mount Garnet, as well as local and coastal areas.

Bullocks were quoted 30¢ easier, Heifers were 20¢ easier, Cows were 10¢ easier and Bulls were 10¢ dearer on last Sale's rates.
