

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS STORE SALE MARKET REPORT Friday – 10th April 2026

**Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 3,199 Store cattle.
The Store Cattle consisted of 1,927 Steers, 1,244 Heifers & 28 x 28 Cows & Calves.**

The first Store Sale of the year was well supported by vendors resulting in the largest sale to date this year.

Feeder Steers attracted good competition from feedlots and live exporters. Good quality pens of straight coloured weaner Steers sold to an enthusiastic panel of local buyers however light weight weaners under 200kg and plainer types struggled to attract any competition.

The yarding was drawn from predominantly the Charters Towers region and coastal areas with isolated consignments coming from Einasleigh, Georgetown, Greenvale, Bowan.
