

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS

PRIME SALE MARKET REPORT

Wednesday – 15th April 2026

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2049 cattle, consisting of 1167 Prime cattle and 882 Store Cattle. Prime Cattle consisted of 144 Bullocks, 108 Heifers, 875 Cows and 40 Bulls. The Store cattle consisted of 519 Steers 346 Heifers and 17 x 17 Cows and Calves

Cattle comprised of only a few good quality pens of meatworks bullocks and prime heifers. The yarding was dominated by well-finished cows and only a small sample of bulls.

The yarding was drawn from Burketown, Torrens Creek, Pentland, Laura, Tully, Mt Garnet, Greenvale as well as local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes:

Bullocks were quoted 5¢ easier, Heifers were 15¢ easier, Cows were 5¢ easier, and Bulls were 10¢ easier on last week's rates.
