

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS

PRIME SALE MARKET REPORT

Wednesday – 1st July 2026

**Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 1,157 Prime Cattle.
Consisting of 413 Bullocks, 154 Heifers, 484 Cows and 106 Bulls.**

Cattle comprised a reduced yarding of prime cattle, mainly consisting of a large run of older Bullocks, isolated pens of fat Heifers and a much smaller offering of Cows. All regular buyers were in attendance however the market received a slight correction in line with the rest of the state.

The yarding was drawn from Normanton, Hughenden, Richmond, Croydon, Einasleigh as well as local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes: Bullocks were quoted 10¢/kg easier. Heifers were unchanged. Cows were 15¢/kg easier and Bulls were unchanged on last week's rates.

- Best priced Trade Heifers were presented on A/c C Gilmore, "Cranford Station", Torrens Creek that sold for 352¢/kg and weighed 540kg to return \$1,901 per head.
- The top pen of Cows were sold by A/c E & S McIntosh for 346¢/kg weighing 645kg to return \$2,232 per head.
- Bulls sold on A/c J O'Sullivan topped at 332¢/kg and weighed 737kg to return \$2,450 per head.
