



ASTHMA & ANAPHYLAXIS - STANDARD

This combined course provides students with the skills and knowledge to manage asthma and anaphylaxis in education or workplace environment.

Course Content:

The course will provide students with skills and knowledge in the following areas:

- Develop a risk minimisation and emergency management plan for an asthma episode
- Assess emergency asthma situations
- Apply the appropriate first aid procedures for an asthma episode.
- Communicate details of emergency asthma incidents.
- Evaluate responses to asthma emergencies.
- Confirm an allergic reaction
- Respond to the situation
- Provide appropriate first aid treatment for anaphylactic reaction
- Communicate details of the incident
- Evaluate response to the anaphylaxis incident
- Develop individual anaphylaxis management plans
- Implement strategies to prevent allergic reactions, including anaphylaxis
- Develop a communication plan to raise awareness of allergic reactions, including anaphylaxis

Prerequisite: No prerequisites required. It is recommended that students hold a current HLTAID001 – Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) Statement of Attainment
