



HUTS. 16 huts retrieved and erected (NissenBow)

DISPOSITION OF COMPANY.

Work in the trenches on the EAUCOURT - L'ABBE-GEUDECOURT front was carried on during the period that 2nd Division were in the line by one section of sappers. Reliefs were arranged to take place about

every fourth day.

Surplus transport wagons were parked under Divisional arrangements. Bicycles and Pontoons were parked at No. 3 R.E. Park.

Drivers and sections not in the line were billeted at BAZENTIN-LE-GRAND camp.

Rations were delivered to Company headquarters in above camp, and transported from there to forward billet in TURK LAKE by Pack-horses.

"C" and "D" Companies repairing roads to BERNAFAY WOOD to LONGUEVAL CIRCUS, scraping same, filling shell holes and laying sleepers.


