RECORD OF VOYAGE FROM MELBOURNE TO SYDNEY.

FRIDAY 11TH JANUARY, 1946.

The Pilot was taken on board at 0530 hrs and we departed from Appleton Rocks at 0600 hrs. The River Pilot was dropped at Williamstown at 0630 hrs, when the Bay Pilot came aboard. A course of 202 degrees was steered, variation being 8 degrees East, until 1000 hrs when it was changed to 238 degrees. At 1025 hrs Queenscliffe inner lighthouse was abeam, and at 1100 hrs the course was changed to 240 degrees. The Bay Pilot was dropped at 1105 hrs and the ship headed down the coast for Cape Schank on course 119 degrees. Cape Schank was abeam at 1350 hrs when the course was altered to 083 degrees. This course was held until Cape Woolamai was abeam and the ship ^{was} turned into the channel for San Remo. At 1815 hrs the engine was stopped and we moored to San Remo jetty. My reason for pulling into San Remo was that I considered Wilsons Promontory too dangerous a coast to navigate at night with the instruments on board. The distance run during the day was 73½ miles.

SATURDAY 12TH JANUARY, 1946.

Started up the engine at 0530 hrs preparatory to pulling out on the full tide. The time of departure was fixed at 0600 hrs, high tide at 0540 hrs; as the tide floods and ebbs at 9 knots and it is not advisable to move when this is in progress. We departed from the wharf at 0600 hrs and cleared Cape Woolamai at 0647 hrs, when the course was set at 117 degrees, variation still being 8 degrees East. Cape Liptrap was abeam at 1200 hrs when the course was changed to 116 degrees for 15 minutes and then changed to 099 degrees. As a current was setting 159 degrees the course was again altered until Great Glennie Island was abeam at 1504 hrs. Having passed the Island the course taken was then 120 degrees until Wattle Island was brought abeam. From then on I remained on no set course but hugged the coast until at 1630 hrs South East Point Lighthouse was abeam. Having rounded the Promontory I changed course to 347 degrees. At 1800 hrs we were abeam of Refuge Cove in which we dropped anchor at 1815 hrs. I decided to stay here for the night and make an early start for Eden

the next day. Our E.T.A. at Eden was to be at 1700 hrs on Monday afternoon. We anchored about half a cable from an R.A.A.F. Crash Boat 02--212 in Refuge Cove. The distance run during the day was 72½ miles.

SUNDAY 13TH JANUARY, 1946.

The engine was started at 0400 hrs and we weighed anchor at 0415 hrs and took 02--212 in tow as she was running low in petrol. Our course was 046 degrees. At 0615 hrs the tow was dropped owing to headwinds. Gliffy Island Lighthouse was abeam at 0650 hrs when I altered course to 042 degrees. At 1530 hrs a ship was passed heading south. Again at 0005 hrs (Monday morning) we passed another ship which signalled us and asked "Where are you from". I replied that we were from Melbourne and headed for Sydney; I asked for our position and he said that we were bearing 025 degrees from Cape Everard. Apparently we had been set out by an unknown current. I immediately changed course to 036 degrees and at 0535 hrs Rame Head was picked up dead ahead. At 1015 hrs Gabo Island was passed and at 1430 hrs Green Cape Lighthouse was abeam. From here on we experienced a beam sea, and at a rough estimate we were rolling 35 degrees either side. Having rounded Red Point we moored to Eden Jetty at 1715 hrs. Distance run was 188½ miles.

TUESDAY 15TH JANUARY, 1946.

We remained at Eden as the engine sump had to be drained and refilled.

WEDNESDAY 16TH JANUARY, 1946.

Engine was started at 0600 hrs and we proceeded to weigh anchor. We had left the Jetty during the night owing to the threat of a South Easterly wind coming up. We spent an hour and twenty minutes in getting the anchor up. In my opinion it is too heavy for the chain, which will not grip the gypsie. The other anchor, also a stockless one, is altogether too light. Having finally catted the anchor we got under way at 0720 hrs. At 1040 hrs I decided to turn back as we were only making about 2 knots, together with the fact that

three of the crew were seasick. We moored once again alongside Eden Jetty this time at 1105 hrs.

THURSDAY 17TH JANUARY, 1946.

As the Nor'Easter was still blowing very hard I decided to delay our departure another day.

FRIDAY 18TH JANUARY, 1946.

I decided to leave port as our fresh rations were finished (The refrigerator was useless in a sea). The engine was started at 0500 hrs and we sailed at 0600 hrs. At 0920 we sighted the S.Y. "Mistral" just off Haystack Rock Lat. 36 degrees 58 mins. S. Long. 150 degrees 06 mins E. Montagu Island came up at 1300 hrs and was abeam at 1400 hrs. Our D.R. speed was about $6\frac{1}{2}$ knots. We changed from our original course of 016 degrees to 024 degrees. At 2150 hrs we passed a ship to Port; another ship was passed at 2340 hrs. Course was changed again to 037 degrees.

SATURDAY 19TH JANUARY, 1946.

At 0115 hrs Perpendicular Point Light came up and was abeam at 0200 hrs when the course was changed to 009 degrees. A ship was passed 2 cables to port at 0140 hrs. Wollongong was abeam at 0800 hrs. We passed a trawler at 1403 hrs and were abeam of Botany Bay at 1450 hrs. We hove to off Sydney Heads awaiting the Danish ship "Manchuria" to drop the Pilot. We cleared the Heads at 1700 hrs and were moored at Clifton Gardens at 1800 hrs.

During the journey the foredeck leaked continuously and both cabins and the fore'ard quarters were affected. The 1 cwt. stockless anchor is useless for holding the ship and the 3 cwt. stockless one is too heavy for the chain which slips every time on the gypsy. I consider an Admiralty pattern anchor of about $1\frac{1}{2}$ cwt. to be ideal for the boat.

The total distance run on the trip was 553 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles. The actual running time was 96 hours, or four days.
