



NEW GUINEA

THE OVERPRINTED AUSTRALIAN STAMPS

1919. 4d King George V Stamps with Large Multiple Crown over A Watermark, overprinted with the Fifth Setting, in which each letter "S" is normal. The "P" of "PACIFIC" is above the space between the "I" and "S" of "ISLANDS".

The following variation of the Overprint appears on this pane -

Stamp No. 23 - black flaw in middle of "W".

These stamps comprise Nos. 1 to 30 of the left pane of the lower sheet (Electro VI) from the Third set of plates. The following identifiable flaws appear -

Stamp No. 2 - white dot left of "I" at right;

17 - large white flaw on right side of uppermost wattle at left.
