ALEXANDRIA. 17th July 1915. My dear Howell Price, Capt. Rawson of the Indian Mtd. Battery is going back today to Anzac and has promised to have this letter sent on to you. I got your letter enclosing Major Lambs papers they seem to have been a lovely journey round the world. I can't tell you how I feel at not being able to come back for a while I was in the Hospital for a week or so and they had a Board on me I am to be sent to England for further treatment and an operation. to the frontal part of my head piece. I have had rather a poor time with bad headaches and general debility and they say it is due to over strain and Frontal something - itis can't remember THE word. The P.M.O. says I have left it too long and it will take a couple of months at least, its all very depressing and I feel as if I don't care much what happens if I can only get health back again. And you dear fellows I hate leaving you but I'm no use to anyone at present. I should only be a drag and a "skeleton at the feast" so they say - I hear that good progress is being made at Gallipoli and I hope soon to hear of the Turks giving up the struggle - God knows we want something to cheer us up. It will be a long struggle before Germany is reduced to submission but we shall win through and I hope still to be back again with you all before the finish. Any parcels which may come for me I want you to take and make use of. Please do this. I shall be so glad if there is anything useful to you or any of you. Any odds & ends which are of no use to you can be put into a pack and sent to the Base at Alexandria. God bless you dear boy don't forget that your old Colonel loves you as he would his own son and I shall always love to hear of you. Yours sincerely (Sig) R.H. OWEN.
