Disclaimer.

This Nominal Roll has been compiled by Major WT Burton OAM (Retd), using records held by DVA, the Nominal Roll contained in Volume Two, of Lieutenant Colonel Bruce Cameron MC (Retd) Book; 'Canister! On! Fire!' (COF). A Nominal Roll contained in 'C' Sqn, Routine orders Part 1, along with other small extracts of information from COF, which I have used to provide some explanatory notes, that may make clear any previously little-known facts, and to provide a small piece of the prevailing atmosphere at the time.

NOTES:

- 1. 3106899 Capt Horne (CMF) was attached to 'C' Sqn, 1 Armd Regt, from Officer Training Group, Southern Command (CMF) for the period 16/3/68 to 30/3/68.
- 2. Maj Wells (CMF) was attached to 'C' Sqn, 1 Armd Regt, from 3/9 SAMR for the period 29/10/68 to 12/11/68.
- 3. All personnel shown in Red were deployed to either FSB 'Coral' or 'Balmoral', and includes Sgts B Vearing and NO Jensen, Lcpl IG Place and Cfn K Matuszczak, who were attached to 'C' Sqn, 1 Armd Regt from 1 Armd Sqn Wksps (RAEME).
- 4. Personnel from 1 Armd Sqn Wksps (RAEME) and 1 Armd Sqn Wksps Stores Section (RAAOC) shown above in Red were also attached to 'C' Sqn, 1 Armd Regt and deployed to FSB 'Coral' and 'Balmoral'.
- 5. 'C' Sqn personnel shown in **Black** above, and who were serving with the Sqn at Nui Dat and elsewhere, during the period 21 May 1968 to 6 June 1968, formed the rear echelon at Nui Dat: They were responsible for local security, rear link communications, messing and administration. Reinforcements to the Sqn arrived on a 'trickle' feed basis, in accordance with personnel replacement needs. The dates of arrivals of individuals, when not with the main 'C' Sqn groups, and in some cases individual departure dates, when earlier than main Sqn groups are shown against their names.
 - All personnel shown in **Black** are entitled to wear the insignia of the UCG.
- 6. The departure of 'C' Sqn personnel and the tanks from Nui Dat for Operation Toan Thang, left the Sqn area almost defenceless. Fortunately, Capt Don Campbell, a RAAC officer who had served with the AATTV, was passing through Nui Dat prior to his RTA and Maj Badman took the opportunity to place him in command of the rear echelon and in a short time the Sqn perimeter was surrounded by a network of Claymores and interlocking arcs of fire. Forward Delivery Troop (FDT) also assisted in this task.
- 7. Sgt DR Campbell served with 'C' Sqn, 1 Armd Regt from 6 Aug 69 until illness forced his RTA on 26 Aug 1968.

Following the Warning Order he had received from the Comd 1 ATF 16 May 1968, which followed the attacks on FSB 'Coral' on the night of 12/13 May, Major Badman carried out a recce of the route from Nui Dat to 'Coral', a trip of 150 km. With this in mind, a meeting of all crews was called on the evening of 16 May 1968. The Sqn was finally called forward by the acting TF Comd, Colonel DB Dunstan on 20 May and the Sqn departed for 'Coral' at 0600 hrs 21 May 1968.

All personnel shown in **Black** are entitled to wear the UCG.

Colour Codes: The colour codes used in the compilation of this Nominal Roll (NR), are as follows:

Black: - 'C' Sqn personnel shown in **Black** on the NR above, were on the posted strength of C/1AR during the period 13 February 1968 until 13 February 1969, and formed the rear echelon at Nui Dat, responsible for a Forward Repair Team (FRT), local security, rear link communications and administration. Reinforcements to the Sqn arrived on a 'trickle' feed basis, in accordance with personnel replacement needs. All personnel shown in **Black** are entitled to wear the insignia of the UCG.

Red: - All personnel shown in **Red** were deployed to either FSB 'Coral' or 'Balmoral', and took part in the fighting there, between 12 May 1968 and 6 June 1968, are therefore entitled to wear the insignia of the UCG.

Blue: - Those personnel shown in Blue, were not on the posted strength of 'C' Squadron, 1st Armoured Regiment, between 12 May 1968 and 6 June 1968, which are the prescribed dates of the Battles of Fire Support Bases 'Coral' and 'Balmoral', and therefore are not entitled to wear the insignia of the UCG. These names and posting dates have been confirmed using the DVA NR of Vietnam Veteran's.

The dates of arrival of individuals, when not with the main 'C' Sqn groups, and in some cases, individual departure dates, when earlier than the main Sqn groups are shown against their names.
