News was received in town during the week of the death of Pte Ron Harper, as the result of illness in a Japanese P.O.W. camp in Malaya. The deceased lad, who was 22 years of age, enlisted early in the war and his whereabouts had been unknown for a long time since Singapore fell, till a few months ago when his name appeared as a prisoner of war in a casualty list. The late Pte. Harper was born here, being a son of Mr. and Mrs. Alf. Harper, residents here up till a few years ago, when they made their home in Bathurst. Mr. B. M. Allen of this town, and Mr. A. Allen, of Gregra, are close relatives of the deceased lad.
