4th Spent at Solloum. Bardia still holding out

5th Solloum, had a swim, but working hard. Bardia fell 1200 hrs.

6th Went through to Tobruk. Working, carrying ammunition.

7th Tobruk, working

8th Still working at Tobruk

9th working

 $10^{\mbox{\scriptsize th}}$ Working, rain. Truck off the road, but nothing broken and nobody hurt

11th Working outskirts of Tobruk

12th Drove all day and all night

23rd Still working around Tobruk

24th Tobruk fell

25th Camped near Derna

 $26^{\rm th}$ Visited an old Egyptian pyramid about 15mls this side of Derna $30^{\rm th}$ Italians evacuated Derna

31st Went around Derna in a big detour, pass was blown up

February

 $1^{\rm st}$ Arrived at Bent, first of the cultivated country, green grass, nice buildings and Italian settlements

2nd Blew a gasket on cylinder head

 6^{th} Passed through town of Barce, best town we have seen so far, nice farms near here

7th Passed through Barcelona

9th Lockra, mostly natives on coast

10th Went to Bengazii

 25^{th} Went surfing at Lockra in morning and working on our trucks in afternoon

 $26^{\rm th}$ Arrived at Barcelona and stayed there all day near an Italian farmhouse. Slept there in our trucks

 $27^{\rm th}$ 180 mls past Bengazii, drove all night to the 8-kilo post outside Bengazii. Slept there $28^{\rm th}$

28

Had a look at a giant Italian bomber plane. Had dinner at an Italian café. Arrived in camp at 9am

March

 $1^{\rm st}$ Spent at Lockra. Reading, nothing startling happened. Tried out some (? rissoles) and cooked a damper

2nd Arrived at Derna. Had a swim in the surf and slept there that night

3rd Arrived at Tobruk. Air raid but otherwise a quiet day

 $4^{\rm th}$ Spent at Tobruk. Nice harbour, which is main attraction of the place. Many sunken ships

5th Stayed at Tobruk, dust storm but not bad, A quiet day

 6^{th} Met Bob (brother) at Tobruk. First time I've seen him for 3 months. Stayed there for the night

 7^{th} Tobruk to Bug Bug. Stayed there, a desolate place- no cultivation 8^{th} Arrived at Mersa Matruth. Went to the Yellow Duck and got a few drinks to celebrate with Bob

 $9^{\rm th}$ Camped at Mersa, warm but a bit windy. Went for a swim with the bovs

 $10^{\mbox{\scriptsize th}}$ Still at Mersa- expecting to move anytime. Sun-baked by the beach

11th Camped at Mersa. Windy and a slight dust storm

 $12^{\rm th}$ Still at Mersa. Warm day, went for a swim with Harry (dads childhood friend) and some of the boys

 13^{th} Spent the day at Mersa Matruth, waiting to move out, fine day

14th Started out from Mersa Matruth, terrible dust storm, held up for 4 hours. Broke an axle at 4pm. Fixed it at midnight. Arrived at

Alexandria at 4 am

 15^{th} Spent the morning settling down and in afternoon we went to Alexandria where we got a good bath

 $16^{\rm th}\, \text{Had}$ a days leave with Bob and some of his mates- had a good time

 $17^{
m th}$ Had another days leave in Alexandria. Saw Deanna Durbin in "Spring Parade", at The Royal Theatre

18th Spent the day at Armaria, near Alexandria

 19^{th} Paraded before General Wavell today and heard a very stirring speech. A fine day

 $20^{\rm th}$ A fine day. Went to Alexandria and got a new uniform. Had some mail from home, waiting to move out

21 st Wrote some letters home. Just another day in camp 22nd Officer Commanding Parade. Nothing startling happened 23rd Had a good days leave in Alexandria. Met Jim Pomeroy there 24th Marched 3 miles, to the train, with full pack. Landed in

Alexandria and boarded the "Berkenshire" transport boat and awaited our departure

 $25^{\rm th}\, Left$ Alexandria at 5.30 and I was pleased to see the last of it. Slept out on deck

 $26^{\rm th}\,\mbox{Fine}$ day and the sea was very calm. Just missed a mine. Sighted land near Greece

27th Landed at Port Pyrus, near Athens. A very nice port. Camped 10 mls from Athens that night. I had 10 shillings. Harry Hall had nothing cause he got fined for speeding and breaking the axle. 10 shillings = 40 drachmas. 1 midi of beer = 7 drachmas

 $28^{\rm th}$ Camped at same place, a great place. It is not to be compared with dusty Egypt

 $29^{\rm th}$ Went to Athens. Had a days leave. Visited the park and the old part of the city

 $30^{\rm th}\, Left$ Athens early and passed through many villages, fertile country. Camped on the roadside for the night

31st Started out early in the morning. Passed through marvellous country, looks like a map from the top of the mountains. We crossed a river, arrived near Mt Olympus. Camped the night

April

Camped near Mt Olympus. On guard duty that night and saw Harry $2^{\rm nd}$ Still camped near Mt Olympus. 1000 feet high. Went for a swim in the creek

 $3^{\rm rd}$ Went to the shooting range and then went for a swim in the creek. Nice warm day

4th Went to the shooting range in the afternoon and saw Harry

5th On guard in camp. Fine day and warm. A really cold night

6th On guard in camp. Rained that night. Blankets got wet. Everything got wet. Very uncomfortable night

7th Lit a fire and dried the blankets in the morning. Shifted our camp late in the afternoon

8th Put our tent up and got settled in camp. Rainy day and we were on guard

9th Rainy day and very cold. Guarding ammo, Boys up all night

10th Still raining. Hundreds of Greek evacuees from Solonika

11th Guarding the DID at old camp. Speaking to Greek evacuees from Solonika

12th Went to Elasson, about 6 miles back. Still raining, it was pretty near snowing

13th Fine day, but still a bit cold. Seen Harry

14th Fine day, warm. Enemy planes over all day. Machine gunned by the enemy (planes), Messerschmitt. We fire on them with our rifles 15th Enemy planes again today. Fired on one with our rifles. Warm day

16th Shifted camp back about 25 miles. Climbed a big mountain and watched 50 bombers bomb Larissa. Went with Vic on truck

17th Larissa in ruins. Machine-gunned truck by enemy, while carrying infantry through Larissa. One killed, two wounded. Lasted 1 and half hours. 7 raids altogether. AAS got plane who attacked it

18th Left infantry at Larissa. Few raids. Carrying supplies west to port east of Larissa and camped at an old aerodrome, at Larissa

19th Dive bombs. Raid, 300 bombs. Big raid. Camouflaged our truck. I was left behind that night (five of us-me, Wally, Charlie and Victor) 20th Air raids all day. About 3 pm Fritz (the Germans) came along with tanks, battle, walked back. Passed through Larissa about 11.30. German..... Passes all blown

21st Camped in infantry lines. Machine-gunned. Set out at night for camp. Picked up by Bob Roberts, after a lot of walking

 $22^{\rm nd}$ Arrived in our camp at 130 am. Slept in an open truck. Got another truck. Destroyed our gear and set out for the front $23^{\rm rd}$ Arrived at the front. Fine day, a few planes. Machine-gunned with Captain Mitchell. Pulled out that night- drove all night

24th Camped at Argus during day. Fine day. Aerial activity and hit the trail again at night. Hundreds of dead mules and people, killed by planes

25th Camped during the day, and drove at night. Large pass and a rough road arrived at foot of Greece at dawn. Passed through Conrith Callamatto

26th Camped near foot of Greece, in village. Fine port town. Bombed by heavy planes

27th 2am, on board destroyer "Costa Rica"- bombed 3 times and sank. Picked up by "Herawarol", a destroyer. Full speed, at 35 knots, for Crete. Arrived in one-hour with Bobbie and 2/11 chaps- saw Bill McCall -machine gunned on wharf

 $28^{\rm th}$ Marched 7 miles to camp. Saw Harry and we re-joined our unit. Fine day. Aerial activity

29th Still on Crete. Mountainous country. Fine day. Air raid- four down. Warm days and cold nights. Went for a swim in the creek 30th Still at Crete. Spent the day resting and swimming in creek which comes down from the snow toped mountains

May

 $1^{\rm st}$ Still at Crete. Warm day. Aerial activity. Cold night. Our planes are doing well here

 2^{nd} Warm day. Clear sky. Creek dries up. Aerial activity. Warm night 3^{rd} Dull day and the creek is running full stream. Big raid on the harbour- warm night

 4^{th} Fine day – but the creek dried up. Aerial activity- waiting to leave the island. Mostly our planes about. Big air raid

 $5^{\rm th}$ Still on the island. "Doomed Man" name given by Lord Haw Haw. Germans patrolling the skies all day- went swimming

 6^{th} Quiet day and no enemy planes about. Went swimming with Rigg and Harry

7th British patrolling the sky and keeping it clear of enemy planes

8th Rainy day and had to sleep in it all night

9th Still at Crete and a bit of aerial activity 10th Aerial activity today, went for a swim

11th Moonlight air raids starts but no damage done

12th Air raid again at night- went swimming during the day

13th Shifted our camp in the morning. Went for a swim and at night there was another raid

 $14^{
m th}$ Daylight air raid on Luda Bay, but no damage done. No night raid $15^{
m th}$ Fine day and no aerial activity up to date. Had some cherry

brandy and some crassy

 $16^{\rm th}$ Went surfing at Suda Bay. German Reconnaissance plane over at 6pm, big raid on Bay. Two bombers crashed together in flames. On guard duty tonight

17th Fine day. Went for a swim in Luda bay, in the morning. Big raid over Bay. One oil tanker on fire. Quiet night

 $18^{
m th}$ German planes over early in morning. More raids after dinner-over 100 planes all day. 2 down, one ship hit

 19^{th} Still at the old camp near the Greek ancient monastery- aerial activity

 $21^{\rm st}$ German parachutes dropped and we evacuated our camp on the flat, to a little gully. Stayed there all day

 $22^{\rm nd}$ Moved out and issued with rifles and we took up a defensive position around Suda Bay. Bombers over all day. Air fleet shot down 100 (? enemy) planes

 $23^{\rm rd}$ Fine day. More troop carriers over earlier. Our troops still doing well

 $24^{\rm th}$ Moved into a forward position, on the island road. Great aerial activity. Saw one of Goerings "Circus Planes" fly low over us-black with yellow markings

 25^{th} Still occupying our positions, near D.I.D. Quiet in the morning but great aerial activity in the afternoon.

Alan Singleton 2nd World War 2 Diary. Middle East, Greece, Italy, Crete

Saw twochase 3 and shot them down

 $26^{\rm th}$ Took over the artillery positions, still further back. Fine day but windy. Built a shelter with Shepherd

27th Big blitz over valley. Bombed village. Walked all night

 $28^{\rm th}\,\mbox{Arrived}$ dispersal area, after being bombed on the way. No food and the water is bad

 $29^{\rm th}$ Marched down to gully that night. Messerschmitt's (German planes) over. Found water but it is not too good

 30^{th} Camped in gully. Not much aerial activity. No food except some green mulberries

31st Still in gully and no food. Boys killed a donkey and ate it. Terrible anxiety, and ever bodies nerves were bad. Terrible experience. All tired out and hungry. Messerschmitt's machine-gunned the gully

June

1st Evacuated Crete at 2am boarded the HMS "Jackal" and we left at 3 am. Quiet trip and we arrived at 5pm. Had a feed on board "The lackal"

2nd Arrived at (?) Amiriya and we got a blanket and a good feed but still tired out and weak

3rd Caught the train for Palestine

4th Arrived at Jules camp where we settled for the night

7th 4 stroke motor, Otto cycle. Induction

Inlet open. Compression both closed. 90 degrees

8th power spark both closed. Exhaust open

 $28^{\rm th}$ Started off on tour of Palestine, Haifa, Nazareth, Tiberious. Had a swim in the Sea of Galilee

29th River Jordan- Jewish agricultural colony, followed the Turkish railway to (?) Nathonya, a seaside resort

30th Started off for Jerusalem. Had dinner and a swim at the YMCA. Visited Tel Aviv and Rehovat

September

4th Prepared for a short trip. Drew pay and new equipment

5th Reveille 4 am. Arrived at Sarafan at 6.15, picked up C.Chev artillery carriers and headed south. Passed through Beindt – Sheba. I camped a few miles further on for the night

6th Went through Sinai desert. Crossed a pontoon bridge across the Suez Canal and drove onto (????)

7th Went to a Greek canteen and in the afternoon went into Ismailia. Had a good time with Mac, Leo and Roy

8th Reveille at 4 am. 6am on our way back, arrived at Jules at 7pm

October

 $13^{\text{th}}\,\text{Settled}$ down in our new camp. Went for a march down to the local stream

 14^{th} Set out from our camp to the railway siding. Loaded with hay and went into Baalbek. Some ... runs there

 $18^{\rm th}\,\text{Set}$ off for Rayak with our truck. Arrived at Rayak and camped the night

19th Set off for Damascus. Passed through Chatuna at the junction of the Rayak road on to the Beirut -Damascus road

 20^{th} Camped at katana, about 15 miles from Damascus- carrying concrete

21st Camped at Rayak

22nd Loaded with nails at Rayak and went to Dimera

 $25^{\rm th}$ took barbed wire into Katana from Rayak. Came back the short way through the hills

December

23rd Bit of an act tonight

24th On guard duty Xmas Eve and its raining and snowing 25th Christmas morning and its snowing. First Xmas I 've ever had in the snow. Had a good dinner and Harry visited me afterwards. We had a drink for Xmas. Had a yarn with Harry and his mates

 $31^{\rm st}$ Came into Baalbek for the $6^{\rm th}$ division Xmas sports. Harry started in the 44D and ran second. Went into the town and had a drink and a talk with Harry

Memorandum (last section in dads diary)

On the $30^{\rm th}$ August, Friday, at 3am we sailed from Sydney Harbour and our first port of call was Fremantle, Western Australia, on the $4^{\rm th}$ September

We left on the 5th September and reached Bombay on the 15th September., HMS "Canberra"

Left our convoy on the 13th September.

We sailed from Bombay on the 19th September and arrived at Port Suez on the 29th September.

We disembarked on the 30^{th} September and arrived at Gaza on October 1^{st} .

We went into camp at Duir Senied November 5th.

We left and went to Barbara.

We stayed there about a fortnight and then went to Egypt.

September 2^{nd} went to Ismalia taking down trucks, arrived back on Monday 7^{th} .
