War Diary - January '44

- 2-1-44 Calculations of absolute calibrations of 30 Dec 43 completed. It was found that No 2 gun, French manufacture had lost 135 ft/sec in muzzle velocity.
- 6-1-44 Absolute calibrations carried out using determined muzzle velocities from previous calibrations. Observations were good. It was found that muzzle velocity determined from previous calibrations 30 Dec 43 was correct. Brigadier Kitto and Lt Colonel Lowe were present.
- 20-1-44 Practice shoot of 20 rounds per gun fired in two series. First series conducted by Lieut Moncrieff; second series " " Williams. Target consisted of one "Hong Kong" towed by L.C.V. Brigadier Kitto, Lt Colonel Lowe and Major Scarlet were present at shoot. Battery visited by Major General Whitlam; Brigadier Baker, Brigadier Kitto and staff.
- 27-1-44 Practice shoot cancelled owing to target towing vessel not available. Battery visited by Major General Milford, Major General Balse, Brigadier Kitto and staff.

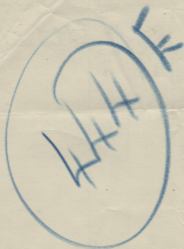

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
