ECOLOMY IN STATIONERY ITEMS.

Considerable difficulty is being experienced in the procurement of adequant surplies of critain stationers items - and in particular all types of panells and the larger sizes of envelopes.

It is imperative, therefore that the surgicust economy be effected in the use of stationary items generally, and that present stocks of pencils and large envelopes be emerged to the utrost.

3. It is apparent from the large derands made upon 4000 co. the Stationery Deprts, that there is an excribitant usage rate in a number of iters, which indicates that the need for concern in this regard is not appreciated. This again applies very seriously in the case as permits.
