I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 20th May, intimating that one machine gun had been allotted to the village of Taralga in this Shire.

My Council desires me to convey its acceptance of the gift, also to say that the President, who is a resident of Taralga, will take immediate steps for election of three Trustees, and to carry out the conditions upon which the presentation is made. The forms to be filled in will be sent you on completion by the Trustees to be appointed.

As there is a population of some 7000 in this Shire, my Council feels that it is justified in making application for two more machine guns for other parts of the area. Trusting you will be able to accede to this request.
