REPORT.

Official inspection of Lae War Cemetery conducted on 8th Jan 47. by Air-Chief-Marshal Sir Keith Longmore and Brig. Brown, of the Imperial War Graves Commission.

Official party arrived by plane at 0900 hrs, and were met by Lieut Frame. Party then proceeded to Lae War Cemetery and carried out inspection. Depression area bordering plots of left hand side of cemetery, still requiring filling in by Mech. Equipment, was inspected by Brig Brown, who reported, that efforts would be made by him to have necessary Mech. Equipment, required to fill depression, made available through Northern Command RAAF or through other sources.

Brig. Brown held a conference in the District Office at 1400 hrs with members of Civil Administration to discuss ~~xxxxxx~~ future problems such as ownership of Cemetery land, water supply and provision for unloading stores and cemetery equipment.

A further inspection was made of Lae War Cemetery by Brig. Brown, and also local area surveyor during the afternoon, when it was decided that the N.W. and Western corner of the cemetery fence could be moved in sufficiently, to enable a road to be put through between the fence and cliff face. This project will not take place for some time to come.

Arrangements were also made for the selection of a residential site on which future caretakers house will be erected.

Official party left for Rabaul the following morning.

All lawn areas mowed during the week and the planting of a bordering hedge around Indian plots was started.


