2. NAMES ON CLOTHING, BOOTS, TOWELS, KITBAGS ETC:

All personnel will mark clothing, boots, towels etc with Army No., rank, name and company. Kit bags will bear name and number only. Haversacks will be marked on the inside of the flap.

3. WASHING OF WORKING DRESS AND TOWELS:

All o/r's will appear in clean working dress at 0700 hrs on Mondays and will have two clean towels.

4. LEAVE APPLICATIONS:

Applications for evening leave will be submitted at the Coy Office by 1630 hrs the day previous except on Mondays when applications will be lodged by 0830 hrs.

Applications for weekend leave will be submitted by 1630 hrs on Thursdays.

5. HUTS:

The occupants of each hut are responsible for its cleanliness and tidiness. All cleaning and tidying will be carried out in the men's own time before the parade at 0900 hrs. Huts shall be open to inspection during parade hours.

6. ENTRAINING:

Complaints have been received regarding the methods adopted by troops generally in entraining at Liverpool Stn. Personnel are expected to show consideration towards civilians, and should wait until passengers have detrained before they themselves attempt to entrain.


