## Australian deminers in Cambodia

With the end of the UN Transitional Authority in Cambodia (UNTAC) in the second half of 1993, the Australian Government decided to establish a small defence cooperation program in Cambodia: Operation Banner. ADF personnel were deployed on a number of schemes, including assisting the UN Development Program's Cambodian Mine Action Centre (CMAC) with demining. In January 1994, the first Australians arrived at CMAC. The first contingent consisted of seven deminers and one communications technical adviser who served six month deployments. In June 1995 the number of ADF personnel serving with CMAC was reduced to four. Following the 1998 Cambodian coup, the Australian Government ended all defence cooperation in Cambodia with the exception of demining. The contingent deployed to CMAC was also reduced.
