✓ Korea Medal To be worn immediately after awards earned for service during 1950/45 War.	Ribbon consists of three (3) yellow and two (2) light blue stripes arranged alternately.	Mentioned in Despatches	Service of one day or more on the posted strength of a unit or formation in Korea since 1 July 1950, inclusive. Official visits, inspections etc, on duty, provided that they amount to 30 days. Travelling time to and from Australia is NOT counted as a qualifying service.
United Nations Service Medal To be worn after Korea Medal. If only award earned, worn as stated above.	Ribbon consists of nine (9) stripes of blue and eight (8) white stripes alternating.		Service in Korea of any period on the posted strength of a unit or formation in Korea since 27 June 1950, inclusive. Official visits, inspections, etc, on duty, provided that they amount to 30 days. Service in Japan on the posted strength of an authorized unit in direct support of the operations in Korea. Travelling time to and from Australia is NOT counted as a qualifying service.
