On 29 Nov I visited this unit at QASTINA. For the past six months or so the unit has been engaged on works at DARWIN and at present is commanded by Lt-Col A. V. Gallasch M.C., its former C O Lt-Col Veale having remained in AUSTRALIA to act as C R E Works DARWIN.

I did not have an opportunity to see anything of the Bn as a whole but my impressions are that they need considerable concentrated training. Arrangements have been made by 9 Aust Div for the 2/1 Pnr Bn to lend them some Bren guns and instructors, but I do not think this is sufficient.

In view of the fact that the unit may have to fight in the Spring it is recommended that, as an urgent matter, steps should be taken to see that this Bn gets special training in all infantry weapons.

Attacks by Aircraft on Vehicles on Roads.

The following is submitted for consideration.

Experiences in Greece indicate that there may be considerable difficulty in the control of troops under the above conditions.

We have also the testimony of our own air people that they dislike small arms fire from the ground.

It would thus appear to be desirable to build up the fighting-back spirit of our own men so that they will engage aircraft after having left their vehicles.

It is suggested therefore to dig slit trenches along stretches of flat straight roads which are particularly vulnerable to aircraft. For a start trenches would be, say, thirty yards from the road and spaced at normal vehicle spacing of 100 yds. Such work could be carried out by the local PWDs without much prejudice to our existing obligations.

It is thought by this means troops would concentrate in these trenches, would be given a certain amount of protection and, more important still, be under control of the senior person present for both fire and general discipline.

It would be possible to practice units occasionally in this type of dispersion.


