



#### 3. MECHANICAL VEHICLES - USE OF GRARS AS BRAKES

The practice of approaching at high speed and then changing down to a lower gear, while still at comparatively high speed, in ord r to obtain the necessary deceleration when slowing down for any purpose e.g. stopping, entering gateways, negotiating corners etc. is still prevenent.

This practice which is forbidden produces excessive engine speeds, causes ennecessary strain on the vehicle transmission system and is a contributing factor to rapid tyre wear.
