11. C.R.E. CIRCULAR A315-1-8 - HOURS OF DUTY - R.A.E. PERSONNEL -  
WESTERN COMMAND.

Attention is directed to the normal hours of duty as laid down by WESTERN COMMAND G.S. Instruction No. 2 of 13 Feb. '45., for administrative Staffs viz 0845 hrs to 1715 hrs for week days - Sat. 0845 to 1230 hrs.

2. The duties of certain RAE personnel may necessitate a departure from these stated hours, but it is the responsibility of all O.C.'s to ensure that all ranks under their command attend punctually at the commencing times of their respective daily routine, otherwise organized parades will be instituted.

3. Should the exigencies of the Service demand it, personnel may be required to remain on duty for longer periods than those stated in para 1. All ranks should be made fully aware of that fact. Leave is a privilege not an entitlement.

4. All addressees will ensure that the foregoing information is passed on to all ranks under their supervision, and that appropriate action is taken in case of default.

12. STOCKTAKING -

Stores Instruction No. 4 issued with these Orders sets out programme of stocktaking to be commenced on 1st August, 1945.

13. G.R.O. 186/1945 - 13/7/45 - MAN MANAGEMENT - PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED WITH MEMBERS HOME, WELFARE & CONDITIONS OF SERVICE.

The following relevant extracts are published herewith for information of personnel.

1. Channels will be organized to maintain and improve morale and discipline in the Army and in particular :-

- (a) to create a closer understanding between officers and men;
- (b) to reduce the AWL rate;
- (c) to obviate the need for applications for leave or transfer on compassionate or emergency grounds;
- (d) to investigate and adjust any representation or complaints relating to conditions of service;
- (e) to reduce the volume of letters written to obtain redress of grievances through unauthorised or improper channels;
- (f) to assist the member in the solution of his family welfare or civil avocation problems;
- (g) to give officers the opportunity to appreciate the incidence on a soldier's personal service of his domestic and civil vocation background;
- (h) to provide and collect information for the benefit of the member and his dependants;



(j) to provide a service link with civil welfare agencies.

In some cases, other ranks are often at a loss when they wish to obtain information informally on some matter, rather than make a formal representation or complaint. As a result, a number of soldiers' difficulties, which could and should be resolved within the unit, are received at LHQ in the form of representations or complaints through irregular channels.

This will be obviated by a Request Hour regarding which further promulgation will be made in Routine Orders.


