Saturdays : Training will cease at 1200 hrs, Lunch at 1215 hrs.

Sundays : As for week days, except mid-day meal at 1215 hrs.

2. MEALS: Men will be fallen in for meals on roadway east of sleeping quarters by C.S.M. five minutes prior to meal times.  
C.S.M.'s must arrange that a N.C.O. be at each table and keep order at meals.  
C.Q.M.S.'s will ensure that meals are ready on time.
3. MESS ORDERLIES: Coy S/M.s will ensure that Mess Orderlies are detailed daily. The following instructions must be adhered to :-  
(a) Ten mess orderlies per Coy. will parade at 0710 hrs to C.Q.M.S. who will march them to their duties.  
They will assist the cooks throughout the day, draw the dry rations, deliver the prepared food to the tables at the appointed times, and will assist with the serving.  
They will also wash up.  
(b) Four other orderlies will be detailed to assist with the serving of meals. They will attend all parades.  
(c) All mess orderlies will be responsible for cleaning mess utensils, tables and precincts, and will return all kitchen utensils to the kitchens in a clean condition.
4. SICKNESS: Except in urgent cases of injury, accidents or other causes, no man reporting sick, except on Sick Parade, will be dealt with by the M.O. All members wishing to report sick will report to Coy. O/R. Cpl. at 0710 hrs.  
Coy O/R. Cpl will prepare Sick Reports (3 copies), and hand over the sick parade to Camp O/Cpl, who will then march the parade to the M.O. All sick personnel must attend C.D.S. If unable to walk they must be carried by orderlies.  
Stretchers are available at C.D.S.  
No man attending sick parade is permitted to leave Camp under any circumstances, unless on parade.
5. FIRE ORDERS: Fire Orders will be placed on Notice Board.  
These Orders must be read to Coys. every Monday Morning.
6. LEAVE: General Leave is granted to all ranks, NOT ON DUTY IN CAMP, from 1800 hrs to 2145 hrs. No other leave will be granted except for special reasons  
No man shall be entitled to more than two week-end leaves in any calendar month. One week-end leave shall be from 1300 hrs Saturday to 2359 hrs Sunday.  
One week-end leave, under special circumstances, shall commence from 1800 hrs Friday and end at 2359 hrs Sunday.  
No mid-week leave will be granted except under special circumstances, and then only after careful investigation by Coy. Commanders, who may recommend the application to the

para 6.

- Camp Commandant for approval.  
In every case where the leave applied for exceeds 48 hrs or the normal weekend leave, it must be approved by the Camp Commandant.  
Leave passes must be clearly marked by the Company issuing the pass.  
Each pass must be handed to the Guard when the member returns to Camp.  
The Sergeant of the Guard will see that the passes are sorted and returned to the Coys.

7. PARKING AREA: All privately owned Motor vehicles must be parked in the parking area before 0800 hrs daily.
8. CLEANLINESS & SANITATION. : All sleeping quarters and vicinity must be in inspection order by 0845 hrs daily.

ORDERS FOR THE CAMP ORDERLY OFFICER:-

1. He will be detailed daily in Camp Orders. His tour of duty will commence at Reveille and end at Reveille the following day.

3. He will see that all parades are formed up at the times ordered.

4. He will collect the daily Sick Reports from the Coy Ord. Cpls. and hand them into the Camp Orderly Room, after noting M.O.s remarks.
5. He will parade the sick men at the hour ordered.
6. He will see that all prisoners confined in the Guard Room are provided with their cleaning materials, shaving gear and bedding.
7. He will see that the Orderlies perform their duties in cleaning their quarters and its immediate vicinity.
8. He will see that the cooks have coffee ready for the guard at 2200 hrs.
9. He will not leave Camp without authority during his tour of duty.
10. He will parade at Camp Headquarters at such time as may be determined to collect & distribute incoming mail.

11. He will report to R.H.Q. immediately on hearing a succession of LONG AND SHORT WHISTLE BLASTS.

APPENDIX "F".

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COY. Q.M.SGTs.

1. Draw stores from C.Q.M. for Coy and sign for same.
2. Make individual issues on A.A.F. F12 s to members of Coy and obtain signatures for articles issued.
3. After all issues have been made to members of his Coy, check stores on issue and in store, and return all stock not required to R.Q.M.S. A receipt must be obtained for all articles returned to C.Q.M.S.
4. Advise R.Q.M.S. daily the number of personnel & horses on strength.
5. Attend to forage and returnable containers & be responsible for same.
6. See that the Mess Huts are kept scrupulously clean and refuse bins are correctly used; that mess orderlies perform their duties punctually and satisfactorily. He will issue rations, having received same from Messing Officer, one half hour prior to meal times. He will ensure that cooks prepare food satisfactorily and on time.
7. He will, when lunches are required in the field, arrange for necessary equipment and food for his Company to be got ready for forwarding at the proper time.
8. He will on return of stores by men obtain their signatures on F 12 s (columns 8, 9 & 10 being used) acknowledging the Non-return of any articles issued, for which the member concerned is definitely responsible.

FIRE ORDERS.

Coy. Comdg. will read these orders to all ranks of their Coy's. as early as possible after arrival in Camp and ensure that they are understood.

A copy will be posted on the Notice Board in Camp.

1. On the outbreak of fire the person discovering it will, immediately give the alarm.
2. Personnell will "Fall in" on the meal parade ground under the Coy. Sgt. Major.
3. C.O. or senior Officer present will order the horses to be cast off and led clear if necessary.
4. The Orderly Officer will take charge of all personnel at the scene of the fire. He will be in command and will organise fire fighting, bucket chain and salvage.
5. The Orderly Officer will arrange to telephone the Captain of the local Fire Brigade if considered necessary.
6. Fire extinguishers and refills, buckets and firebeaters - (wet corn sacks-) will be available at the Q.M.Stores, Orderly Rooms, Mess Huts and kitchens.
7. No naked lights are to be used in any occupied building or tents, nor will any lamps be left burning in any empty building.
8. Persons using matched, cigarette, etc., will see that they are carefully extinguished before being thrown away.
9. When on duty outside the Camp area every care must be exercised to prevent grass fires. Smoking and lighting of fires will only be permitted on the orders of the Coy. Comdg.

## APPENDIX "H"

DUTIES OF N.C.O. IN CHARGE OF SLEEPING QUARTERS.

1. He is at all times responsible for the discipline and general tidiness of area allotted him.
2. He will detail an orderly per sec. daily, who will keep the surroundings clean.
3. He is responsible that no lights are shown, and no noise is made in the area after LIGHTS OUT.
4. Before 9a.m. parade he will see that the area is thoroughly cleaned out. Bedding, etc. will be placed as follows:-  
 "a" Palliase will be rolled on the ground-sheet and placed lengthways in the space occupied by the man to whom it is issued.  
 "b" Blankets will be folded neatly and placed on top of the palliase and groundsheet.  
 "c" Greatcoats, neatly folded, will be placed on top of the blankets.  
 "d" Equipment when not in use will be placed on top of the greatcoat.  
 "e" Kit bags will be placed on top of bedding.  
 "f" Towels, neatly folded will be placed on top of kit bag.
