(j) Sufficient credit must be available in the member's paybook to cover the amount it is desired to invest in the Loan. The amount

subscribed will be debited in the paybook.

(k) Paymasters may accept cash in payment of a Loan subscription, in which case the amount tendered will be entered in the paybook to establish the necessary credit and an official receipt issued and pasted in the paybook.

(1) The Corrienwealth Bank will forward to members an interin

receipt for the amount subscribed.

(m) General

Both Treasury Bonds and Inscribed Stock are readily realisable and may be sold at any time, Any Bank will arrange this for the rember if desired.

(n) Where practicable, the substance of this Order will be explained

to personnel on parade.

4. POWERS OF SMITTRIES AND GUARDS (G.R.O. A.648)
(a) Regulation SA of the National Security (General) Regulations (Statutory Rules 1942, No. 374) provides that, without derogating from or restricting the existing powers or rights of sentries and guards. a military sentry or guard stationed or posted at, on, in, or in the neighbourhood or vicinity of, any prohibited place, protected area, controlled area, or any premises used by the Cornenwealth, or used for defence purposes or for essential services, or any vehicle, vessel or aircraft used by the Cornenwealth, or any enclosed wharf or picking

up place, or any merchant vessel lying in port, or any road, pathway or waterway, specified in an order by the Hinister, which passes through or near a prohibited place or work of defence, may be armed, and may (1) use his weapons against, or otherwise attack, any person who, in disregard of a warning given by a sentry or guard, approaches, enters, leaves, or masses over or in the vicinity or neighbourhood of, or attempts to approach, enter, leave

pass over or in the vicinity or neighbourheed of, that place, area, profiles, vehicle, vessel, afteraft, when', Medking up place, read, mithour, or who rawy, or who, after being arrested

for so doing, escapes; and (ii) uses his weapons against, or otherwise attack, any person attacking him or who is reasonably suspected of being about to attack him.

There are, however, certain principles which must guide all sentries and guards in the execution of their duty as such, and in the oxercise of the right to resert to arms.

(c) These principles are:-

(i) Sentries and guards will be ordered to take any action required to ensure the safety of their posts or to defeat the activities of energy, or suspected energy, agents.

(ii) If necessary, they will fire upon or otherwise attack any person threatening the safety of their posts or engaging in

hestile actions.

(iii) Before firing upon any person, the sentry or guard will, except in an urgent case of solf defence, challenge that person to "Halt". If that person does not halt, the sentry should challenge him again with "Halt or I fire".

-3-4. (Dont) If he does not halt, and no other means are available for stopping hin - as for example, by calling on the rest of the guard - it is the duty of the sentry to shoot. (iv) The sentry will use his intelligence and sense of responsibility in cheesing whether he will shoot or not, and he rust be careful not to allow any suspected person to appreach so close that he can be rushed and overpowered. (v) Guards of enery prisoners of mar, in enery prisoner of war attempting to escape may be fired upon, but a provious summent to surrender will be given if [Masible.]

(vi) quards of norhors of the Ecross in custofy.

(A) An essert of quard is not sustified in using his weapons merely for the purpose of preventing another member from oscaping from custody and if he so uses his weapons he may render himself, as well as any officer or N.C.C. under whose orders he acts, liable to be charged with murder, manslaughter or incitement to murder.

(B) If a nerber in custody attempts to escape, the escort or sentry will irrediately raise the alarm and give chase, Ho may call upon any passer be to assist him in

apprehending the escapeo.

(C) An escert or guard may be justified in using his weapons when a number in custody resorts to violence. In such circumstances an escert or guard may meet force with force, but care must be taken to use no more force than is necessary to evercene the violence effered, Hence, even when viclence is offered to an escert or guard, it will only be as a last resert that the use of weapons will be justified.

Orders for guards and sentries will be framed in conformity with the above and guards and sontries will be suitably instructed

as to their powers and duties.
