(c) Footbaths (pot. permang) to be installed daily.

Latrines. Good.

Grease Traps. Double traps installed outside each kitchen
increasing efficiency to about 5 %. Traps
far too small. Big grease traps to be made
out of wood and installed 100 yds from kitchens.

Drainage. Monster grease trap draining 11 and 12 Sqs pulled
to bits and converted into soakage pit.
Unfortunately it was the apple of the Hygiene
Offr's eye and consequently the RMO suffered
tirade of abuse on the H.O.'s return from leave.
Drains to be left as they are apart from covering
in the more proximal ones which are showing a
regrettable tendency to become blown and breed
mosquitoes.

Rations. Men - fairly good.
Offrs - off slimming diet and putting on weight.

GENERAL HEALTH: Good.

QM's WAR DIARY REPORT FOR JUN 44

CONTROLLED STORES

All types of arms are now up to full WE Strength.. Other stores which were treated by Bde Ord Wkshops have either been returned to the Rert as A.1 or written off. An additional eleven No.11 Wireless Sets were received in lieu of No.22's and No.20B's.

During the month of May, the Corps Pool was established to allow units to draw weapons not shown on WE for training purposes. The Reet took full advantage of this Pool to obtain Vickers and Mortars, both 3-in and 2-in. PIAT's were also obtained as well as a limited supply of practice ammunition.

WET STORES


There was little change in the position of May as regards non-controlled stores.

CLOTHING

With most of 2/11 and 2/12 Sqns on leave, very little replacement clothing was required. 2/4 Sqn was brought up to full issue on their return from leave.

AASC SUPPLIES

No apparent change in the scale of Rations. Certain essential expense stores are unprocurable - e.g. Disinfectants in particular.

1. AMENITIES - ORs CLUB

(i) Opening Date. 25 AUST ORs CLUB (AACS) will open in RAVENSHOE on Mon 19 Jun 44.

(ii) Hours. The Club will be open from 1700 hrs to 2230 hrs daily.

(iii) Service. The Club will provide (a) Milk bar. (b) Hot or Cold meals.

(iv) Personnel. The use of the Club is restricted to ORs only.

INTER-CAMP BUS SERVICE.

(v) Commencing Date. Regular Bus Service will commence on Monday 19 Jun 44.

(vi) Routes. There will be four routes. This Regt will use Route 3.

Route 3. Mt GARNET Road between 2/3 Aust Pnr En lines and RAVENSHOE. (Note: at the discretion of the Duty NCO i/c bus, passengers along Route 2 may be picked up providing there is no overloading.

Route 4. Sundays only - Mt GARNET-TULLY FALLS Roads between 2/3 Aust Pnr En and HQ 9 Aust Div.

(vii) TIME TABLE.

Route 3. 20 minute service.

(a) First Bus leaves 2/3 Aust Pnr En 1600 hrs.

(b) Last Bus leaves RAVENSHOE 2315 hrs.

Route 4 - Sundays only. In addition to the normal services on the various routes an hourly service will be run on Sunday as follows :

This Time table is provisional and will be subject to alteration from time to time.

(viii) Overloading. Overloading of buses will NOT be permitted. Control of loading of buses will be supervised by a Duty NCO travelling in the Bus.

(ix) Use of Service. This Service is intended for casual visitors to the Club or Inter- Camp, and cannot cope with large parties from units attending Pictures or other Social functions.

(x) Markings. Buses will be clearly marked with destinations.

(xi) Stops. Buses will stop only at recognized stopping places which will be clearly sign-posted.

AMENITIES (Contd)

(xii) Unit Personnel.

Personnel desiring to avail themselves of the facilities of the Club, will require Leave Passes. They will be correctly dressed in dress laid down for leave., i.e., Hats, chin-strap under the chin, JG or KD with belts and gaiters. If Jersey Pullovers are worn, they will be worn outside Slacks with Belt waist outside Jersey.

Conduct of Troops. On these visits to RAVENSHOE will determine number of leave passes issued. Personnel are reminded that members from each unit in the Division will be visiting the Club, and to conduct themselves in a proper and soldier-like manner.

(xiii) Duty NCO.

Duty Sen will provide on 16 Jul to 18 Jul 44 (both dates incl) NCOs of rank of Cpl or above to report to HQ 156 Aust Gen Tpt Coy AASC as follows :


(a) Duties of NCOs - The Duty NCOs will be allotted - 1 to each bus - by AASC, and each will remain with his Bus as NCO i/c, and in this capacity will ensure:

- (1) That the Bus is not overloaded
- (2) That the conduct of the troops embarked is orderly
- (3) That the Bus doe NOT exceed the speed limits existing in the Area
- (4) That any unsafe driving or breaches of discipline amongst the passengers is dealt with at once, and later reported in writing to an officer of his own unit.

(b) Reports by Duty NCOs - Reports by Duty NCOs of unsatisfactory conduct experienced during their tour of duty will be made out in writing and forwarded to HQ by 0800 hrs on the day following.

2. SPEEDING.
