REPORT UPON MARAUA / MSUS RA THERMOS BOMB

As instructed by you I detailed a party under Lieut Perg to proceed along above road & demo lish THERMOS bombs.

At fork on road 26 miles from MARAUA - 26 bombs were located, 18 were exploded & 6 upon being hit two or three times failed to explode. 


