We have suffered several refusals in the matter of sites selected but have now received the sanction of the Dept. of Justice to use the N.E. corner of the Court House grounds. This edifice is to be rebuilt, we understand, in the near future; moreover, it is expected to be able to make a permanent site for the trophy in the Recreation Grounds, hence

the matter of sleeper base being suggested.
