- Disciplinary action will be taken against unauthorised personnel removing equipment from these dumps.

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

- 1. There will be no smoking in the vicinity of the Petrol Dump.
- Great care will be exercised when tanks of vehicles are being repleniabed. Engines will be switched off and any petrol spilled will be sprinkled with sand.
- Maked lights and hurricane or pressure lamps will in no circumstances be taken near the Fetrol Dump or anywhere near a vehicle being refuelled.
- All ranks will exercise great care in the disposal of digarette butts, matches and pipe ashes. All ranks will onsure that digarette butts are not thrown near enything inflammable.
- 5. Maked Lights in tents will be carefully shielded, and candles placed in approved holders.
- 6. Pires will not be permitted within 3 yards of tents.
- A drum of sand and a shovel will be kept in a position close to the Fetrol Dump.
- 8. A number of 44 gallon drums will be distributed over the area, and kept filled with water.
- 9. The C.S.W. will ensure that the drums are kept filled.
- Pire buckets are provided on the basis of two to each drum, and will not be removed.
- A Fire Picquet of 1 NCC and 6 O/Rs will be detailed weekly by O.C. 'A' 'R' 'F' 'R' & RDI area, and by Adm Offr on Coy NQ for NQ & Wheshop's Area.
- 12. The Fire Picquet will not leave the camp area without permission.

(d) No Coy vehicle may leave Coy area unless AAF G.2 properly

(k) Rifles of picquets off beat will not be loaded or have mag-

azines charged.

(1) NCO 1/c will remind Picquet of their responsibilities with regard to firing of live assaunition, as per Coy RO Serial

No.9/45 Para 54, copy of which is appended for information.
(m) NOO 1/c Picquet will submit a report to Orderly Officer by 2000 hrs daily.

(n) Dress will be normal, and web equipment, rifle and bayonet, will be carried.

(o) Soldier on duty during the day at the entrance of the area, will pay necessary compliments to all officers.

FOWERS OF SEETRIES AND GUARDS

1. Regulation SA of the Mational Security (Ceneral) Regulations (Stabutory Rules 1948 No 374) provides that, without deregating from or restricting the existing powers or Fishe of centrides and guarde, a Military contry or mars and powers or rights to contrave and guarde, a silterly contry or mars stationed or posted at, on, in, or in the neighbourhood or vicinity of, any prohibited place, protected area, controlled area, or any premises used by the Commonsealth, or used for defence surposes or for essential nervices, or any vehicle, vessel or aircraft used by the Commonwealth, or any enclosed where or picking up place, or any marshant ves-sal lying in port, or any read, pathag or waterway specified in an order by the Minister which passes through or near a prohibited place or work of defence may be armed and may -

(2) use his seapons against, or otherwise attack any person who, in disregard of a warning given by a sontry or guard, approaches, embers, leaves, or passes over or in the violity or neighbourhood of, that place, area, premises, vehicle, vessel, sireraft, wharf, placing up place, reade, pathway, or waterway, or who, after being arrested for so doing escapes; and

(ii) uses his weapons spained, or otherwise attack, my person attacking him or who is reasonable suspected of being about to attack

him.

There are however, certain principles which must guide all sentries guards in the execution of their duty as much, and in the exercise and of the right to resert to arms.

3. These principles are; -

(a) Sentries and guards will be ordered to take any action required to ensure the safety of their poets or to defeat the activities of onemies or suspected enemy agents.

(b) if necessary they will fire upon or otherwise attack any person threatening the safety of their past or engaging in hostile ac-

tion.

(e) before firing upon any person, andry or guard will, except in an urgent case of self defence challenge that person to make If that person does not halt, the sentry should challenge him again with "Halt or I fire"! If he cose not halt then and no other means are available for stopping him - as for example, by calling on the rest of the guard - it is the duty of the sentry to shoot.

(d) the sentry will use his intelligence and sense of responsibility in choosing whether to shoot or not, and he must be careful not to allow any suspected person to approach so close that he can

be rushed and overnowered.

(e) Source of enemy prisoners of Mar. An enemy prisoner of war attempting to cookie may be fired upon hat a provious sussense of manuscraft will be given if possible.

(f) Owards of members of the forces in quabody.

(1) An escort or guard is not justified in using his weapons serely for the purpose of neverthing snother nember from searching from unstody and if he so uses his weapons he say render himself as well as any officer or N.C.O. under when corners he acted liable to be charged with survice, manufacuphor. ter or incitement to mirder.

(11) if a member in oustody attempts to escape the escart or sentry will issediately raise the skarm and give chase. He may call upon any passer-by to assist him in apprehending

the escapes.

(111) an escent or guard may be justified in using his weapons shon a momber in quatody recorts to violence. In such cirounstances an escort or guard may meet force with force, but care must be taken to use no more force than is necessary to overcome the violence offered. Hends even when violence is offered to an escort of guard it will only be as a last resort that the use of weapons will be justified.
