- 5. The new D-&M School commenced 11 Oct '43 and will continue until 22 Nov '43 This School will be conducted as per appendix "A" to LHQ 35M3965. The intake to this course is 67. Those qualifying will be issued with full drivers licenses vide 3 Aust Corps training Instructions No 18;
- 6. Attention is drawn to the fact that six of the instructors have qualified as such at LHQ school of Mechanisation.
