Notes on Conference at Brigade H.Q. Q/cliff 29th Jan. '42.

(1) Returns of work completed for the week must be sent to Brigade H.Q. on time each week.

(2) Liason Officers appointed as contacts between Bge. and the various Units in the Area.

(3) Camouflage of positions and emplacements must be efficient.(4) Priority to be given to the work on forward Beach positions.

(5) Reserve Petrol and S.A.A. dumps to be established.

(6) Water supplies for forward Areas to be held in drums.(7) Necessity of allotting transport to 3" Mortar crews so that

best use can be made of limited number of Mortars available.

(8) Respirators to be carried always between dusk to dawn period.

Need not be carried during the day because of liability to damage.

(9) Discipline and dress to be maintained by all ranks. All ranks to salute. Curb bad language especially round occupied areas.

(10) Necessary to continue training. Something should be learnt each week or practised each week as opportunity offers.

Notes on Conference at Brigade H.Q. Queenscliff.

(1) Too many sandbags being used to protect positions. Must be conserved and timber or brush used wherever possible.

(2) If and when attack comes no retreat from defensive positions. May as well fight it out on beaches.

(3) Revolvers to be worn by Officers at all times.

(4) Return of work done for the week to be forwarded to Bde. H.Q.

(5) Vital importance of carrying out M.V. maintenance.

(6) Urgent need for full Equipment.

(7) Personnel to be billeted at their posts as soon as possible from today. 3 weeks duty, one week rest back in lines.

(8) Men must be impressed with the necessity of observing proper methods of Hygiene and Sanitation.

(9) Use of paper in office must be cut down.

(10) Short Cas School for selected personnel to be arranged as soon as possible.

Notes on Conference at "Maytone" Queenscliff.

- (1) No leave for anyone during stand to periods.
- (2) Leave allowed at 24 hrs. per wook for 1/7 of the strength. Can accumulate to 48 hrs per fortnight or in the case of country personnel ONLY can accumulate to 4 days per month.
- (3) One free Home Leave Pass to be given per month.
 - (4) One half day per week to be set aside for tabloid sports in which everyone is to participate.
 - (5) Life saving Patrols to be organized for the Ocean Beaches.
