PREVALENCE OF THEFT OF MILITARY STORES & SUPPLIES.

vide GRO 24/46, of 11 Jan 46.

1. The offences of stealing and fraudulent misapplication of stores and supplies from military depots, installations, transportation services and even from fellow soldiers are still causing concern and the necessity for immediate and effective remedial action still exists.
2. The use of terms such as "pilfering", "scrounging" etc, to describe such offences, tends to obscure their gravity and may cause them to be somewhat lightly regarded. On the contrary, such offences must be viewed very seriously and offenders will render themselves liable to severe punishment.
3. As a general rule, no suspension or remission should be made in respect of any award or sentence imposed upon a member for any offence mentioned in this order.

1. The supply situation in regard to rubber is still serious and it is imperative that every ounce of rubber in use by the Army should be conserved to the utmost. The use of vehicles is to be restricted to essential requirements.
2. When vehicles are used, the following six points will be rigidly enforced :-
 - (i) Don't speed; avoid rapid acceleration, harsh braking and fast cornering.
 - (ii) Check pressures daily with gauge to protect side walls and save tread wear.
 - (iii) Keep brakes equalised, wheels true, and watch for misalignment
 - (iv) Interchange tyres at prescribed intervals to keep wear even.
 - (v) Closely inspect tyres daily, remove any stones, and repair minor cuts.
 - (vi) Report defects immediately.


