During this period, O.C., V.C.C. and V.C.Secs. has been operating as Officer Commanding N.Comd. A.A.S.C.(M) Tng. Depot, Enoggera, and the O/Rs of the V.C.C. and V.C. Secs. have undergone instruction there.
