# 6. HOSTILE AIR ATTACK - ACTION OF TROOPS

Attention is again drawn to A T # (Anst) No 7 Appx 19' setting out instructions a to conduct of the when faced by hostile air attack. All Pl cond will ensure that the inst contained in the appy are made known to all runks and is <u>practiced</u>. This is particulerly important as regards movement of M T. The following rules must be fully learned:-

- (a) On coming to a new position, slit trenches must be dug immediately.
- (b) On the approach or sighting of one or two planes obviously on recoed duty, personnel in tents or buildings remain there. If out of doors atop into shadow. If in the open, stand still.
- (c) If attacked or an attack appears imminent, the 0 0 will order tps into trenches. Tps caught at a distance from trenches must lie down and NOT run to their trenches.
- (d) Tps marching and/or M T, carrying tps or <u>NOT</u>, will continue to move as ordered.
- (e) Observe the principle that one bomb must NOT destroy more than one vehicle or one tent.

# 7. DISCIPLINE G S R 60/1/27

 In order to improve the standard of elementary training and discipline among the troops of Tasmania Force, the following action will be taken:-

- (a) Commencing 17 Aug 42 for four weeks, two periods of <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> hr each week will be allotted each week to elementary drill.

# 9. USE OF INDELIELE PENCILS GR 0 0304/42

1. Indelible pencils contain a dys which, if allowed to penetrate under the skin, one in certain instances produce damperous results. The damper is caused mainly by the pencils piercing the skin or fragments of the lead working under the skin.

2. Where it is necessary that indelible pencils be used, all concerned will be instructed that every precaution it to be exercised.

10. COMPLAINTS BY MEMBERS OF THE FORCES G.R. O A. 108/42

 The attention of all ranks will be directed to A.M.R.& 0. 293 (1), which provides as follows:-

"Officers and soldiers are forbidden to use any method of obtaining redress of real or supposed grievences other than those prescribed by the A.M.R. or authorized by these orders. Anonymous complaints and complaints through the press are forbidder."

2. The use of outside influence is forbuilden by A.M.R.& O. 307 (1) which provides :-

"The use of outside influence to support complaints or applications for personal advantages, or in any matter affecting the position of any officer or soldier, is contrary to discipline. The only proper course for an afficer or soldier is to apply through his GLO or to complain in accordance with the ALML, and these orders. Any strengt to obtain favourable consideration of requests or grievences by other meets is favourable consideration of requests or grievences by other meets is favour-

3. The provisions of Division 1 of Part IV of the A.M.R.& 0, will be explained to all formed units on parale at least once in every three months, and to all members in training depots once every month. The consequences of failing to observe the provisions of that Division will be made clear.

4. All complaints or applications of the nature described in para 2 above received at any H.Q. through unauthorized channels will be forwarded to the unit concerned, with a direction that the number will be paraded and informed of the Unit Order on this matter and that any further failure to observe its provisions will be dealt with as an offence.

# 19. ACTION TO BE TAKEN WHEN NATIONAL ANTHEM IS PLAYED G R 0 109/42

 It has been observed that a lack of uniformity exists regarding action to be taken by officers and other ranks when the National Anthem is played. A.M.R.& 0 1153 and 1154, are repeated here and are to be uromulated to all ranks:-

(1) Whenever the National Anthem is played all renks in military unform not under the orders of the officer commanding the parade are to stand at attention, officers, W.O.'s and N.C.O.'s subtitude.

(2) Officers in attendance on His Majesty and other Royal Personage or the Personal Stafts of Overmort-General and Overmorefemeral or Covermore represent the Soversign on official coccasions) are to asult when the National Anthenis is played for the royal salute. The only exception is an an occasion of the trooping of the colourt when the National Anthen is played on the presentation of rams to the colour, all officers, including those in attendance, are to salutes. On a parade, after the royal salute has been given, the Nilitary Board or officer commanding is alone to be regarded as in attendance, and is to take up position in rear of His Majesty or the Covernor case the coverney bes

1154. When the National Anthes is played on occasions when there is no parade, or on occasions of a non-military nature, all remks in military unform are to stand at attention, officers, W.O's, and N.G.O's adulting.

# 12. NATIONAL SECURITY (Lendlord and Tenant) REJULATIONS. GR 0 A. 110/42

This direction is issued under the National Security (Liquid Fuel) Regulatins, breaches of which are punishable by a fine of up to \$100 or six months' imprisionment or both.

# 1. INTERFERENCE WITH SIGNAL COLDUNICATIONS (Ref G R C G 256)

1 The practice of firing weapons from troop trains or 1 T vehicles on roads is forbidden. Many instances of damage to insulators and telegraph wires, resulting in considerable delay in communications, have been attributed to this.

2. If a telegraph wire is broken, the channel of intercommunication is immediately interrupted, and the fault must be located before the service can be restored. To effect repairs, line parties must be sent distances of up to 100 miles.

 If the insulator only is broken, the wire will rest on or touch intermittently the cross-arm, producing a fault which is very difficult to locate.

Where the circuit concerned is of the "carrier" type, two or more telephone and telegraph channels may be effected.

The vital importance of maintaining these channels of communication is self-evident.

3. This order is to be promulgated to all units and to R T Os who will bring it to the notice of each O C Train. O Gs Trains or Road Convoys will be held responsible that the order is carried into effect. Misciplinary action will be taken for all breaches.

# 2. FRAMING OF CHARGE SHE ITS (D R 0 543/7)

 Under the National Security Regulations, it has been declared that all persons subject to Military Law on or after 15 Apr 42 are on "active service".

2. Some difference has occurred in the manner of framing charge sheets under these altered conditions.

3. The following is an example of the correct way in which all charge should be drawn and will be adopted in all cases:-

The accused No. Pte. Christian Name. Surmane Battalion, is charged with having, while being a soldier of the Military Porces of the Commonwealth of Australia on war service, committed the following offence:-

A A 18 (4) When on active service stealing public property, in that he, stervice, stole two punds, when on active service, stole two punds, ton shillings and fourpence, public moreay, from a cash-box in the Orderly Room of the Battalion.
